The Vision and Strategic Action Plan project, which will run now through February 2024, aims to create a vision that understands the whole community, reflects core community values, addresses emerging trends and issues, and imagines a preferred future, all with feedback from the community. Once the community vision has been established, a Strategic Action Plan will be developed with defined priorities, realistic, achievable targets, and milestones that measure the City's progress throughout the next five years.
